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# OUR VALUES

The defense of peace through intercultural dialogue is inscribed in the United Nations Charter, which was followed by the creation of UNESCO. In a contemporary world facing crises, climate change and conflicts, this charter must be supported by international associations.

Each ActualiTeam is a club, an association, or a radio program, for debate between young people on current affairs and social issues, connected to the network of the International Federation of Young Citizens' Debate, known as FYCD.



FYCD is currently the 61st member of the Convention: "Protection and promotion of the diversity of cultural expressions", known as the 2005 UNESCO Convention and an official member of the 4000 Clubs for UNESCO in the world. It is the echo of all the AcualiTeams at UNESCO, and soon at the UN and the Council of Europe.

Have you been approached by one of our ambassadors? And you are obviously convinced, just like us, that the debate can be beneficial on an individual and collective scale.

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You are motivated to create your own debate club, here is our conception of the commitment:

- Personalized, according to your dispositions
- social, societal
- understanding of society and its governance on an international scale
- a contact book among associations, students and young people around the world. (Meetings in remote but feeling of world tour guaranteed). Ps: Improve your English with us!
- team management and construction of concrete projects between young people on all continents
- Spoken languages: French and English
- open to your own initiatives
- Multiplying the supports (TV, Radio, web, Team of young people on the ground, UNESCO, Ministries, Institutions attached to UNESCO and the UN...)

It is up to you to create and support your team, your project, your values. Our associative firm can accompany you at each step and subsequently integrate your project into a defense of the values of peace through intercultural dialogue on a global scale.

### Recruit your youth team

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- First, talk to your friends, your students, and anyone else you know who might be interested in participating.
- There are many ways to convince your prospective members:
  - Don't hesitate to highlight the fact that your club will be a member of the UNESCO network! This means that you are helping to promote the values of peace through the UN's intercultural exchange.
  - Youth Debate: A Way to Develop Eloquence, Self-Confidence and Self-Reflection
  - Stay connected to current events and have fun with your friends and future members. From experience, sometimes we have a good laugh!
  - Meet young people from other ActualiTeams around the world during remote events. Open your mind!
  - If you want to recruit more, turn to local and student associations. We can also put you in touch with UNESCO's institutional and associative networks at your regional and national levels for future meetings or partnerships!
- You need to appoint a young person to be the "leader" of your debate club, who will act as a liaison with our office and our Federation office.

### Decide together on the regularity of your debates, the place, and how to choose your topics

- You are free to choose the regularity of your debates (once a month, once a week, every 2 weeks), it all depends on your members' desires!
- The subjects are also voted among you according to the current events and the society themes you wish to tackle. We will just ask you as and when the topics you address, this is our way to have an observant look on your club!
- A messenger group or Watts'app between you can be useful! And generally we are also present in your discussion group to accompany you!

# Want to participate in the activities of the Federation? - Nothing is mandatory

- Every week, the ActualiTeam'Pro - a weekly radio show on Radio Campus Lille presented by journalism students - provides an overview of the topics addressed by the different ActualiTeams around the world.


- At any time, for a subject of debate, or a logistical concern, your team can benefit from an enlightened listening, with the Federation's associative consulting firm, which gathers former members of student associations' boards.

- At any time, you can give feedback on your associative experience, which we will relay to UNESCO. We can also put you in touch with UNESCO's institutional and associative networks at your local and national level with the aim of meetings or partnerships!
- Sometimes, we will contact your leader in order to propose to your team video debates with other ActualiTeams.
- Sometimes, we will ask your leader to propose to your team if it wishes to give an opinion on such or such project to be supported and which would be submitted to the vote of the 150 member states and the EU signatories of the 2005 Convention.


